SELECTION PROCESS

- Commitment to entering the EMS profession.
- Financial need.
- Dedication to the community.
- Ability to serve as a positive ambassador to the EMS profession

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. 16 years of age by the time of admission to the EMT Program
2. No felonies or misdemeanor convictions*
3. Able to perform the job functions of an EMT

GUIDELINES

1. Does not apply to accelerated course option.
2. Recipient must begin the educational program in the term for which the award is granted.
3. Recipient will fully complete the EMS program for which scholarship is awarded. Recipient who withdraws or discontinues the educational program prior to completion for reasons within his or her control (i.e., dropping the course, academic dismissal for absences, etc.) must immediately refund scholarship funds. No refund will be required for recipient who is unable to continue in the EMS program for reasons beyond their control. Proof of reasons for program termination will be required.
4. Recipient must maintain passing grades and remain in good standing throughout the course of study. Recipient may be asked to submit grades each term prior to the next scholarship payment.
5. Recipient of EMS scholarships must seek certification by testing upon completion of their EMS educational program.
6. Recipient must sign a contract agreeing to these scholarship guidelines.
